- Q: Who currently provides this service?  
Link Transit.
- Q: How many vehicles and drivers are needed to provide the level of service expected?  
One to two.
- Q: If Link Transit currently provides this service, would any of the existing drivers be available to transfer to People For People to provide it?  
Link is currently forcing work to meet its demand as a result choosing to subcontract. The demand for this has increased as we expanded service areas and frequency while our workforce has decreased. The contractor may choose to recruit Link staff and drivers during their off time.
- Q: I saw in your RFP that during the past year there were 30 trips/month, how many trips were provided prior to 2020? Trips per day of the week? Trips per time of day?  
30 trips a month is an error, we consistently are providing 12 passengers more than 30 round trips per week or 60 one way trips per week trips are between Cashmere and Wenatchee alone most trips are Monday through Friday between 6:30AM– 5 PM providing work trips to Stimilt, CrunchPak, dialysis, Wenatchee valley clinic, Cashmere Convalescent  
Additionally beyond that we have a few trips staying within Leavenworth after 5PM-9PM a few days a week and a limited number of trips on Saturday and Sunday in the corridor.
- Q: How many service hours/month have been used for this service last year? Also, how many service hours/month prior to 2020?  
Last year a number of these people could not travel  
Our service does not split out these trips from our current service ie the trips are currently being spread over a dozen vehicles and combined with other trips. We changed our service from 2020 expanded availability, frequency, and service area the result increased the number of eligible riders for our service that was very limited prior to this change.
- Q: How many service miles/month have been used for this service last year? Also, how many service miles/month prior to 2020?
