



**FIXED ROUTE REDUCED FARE ID CARD - \$4.00**

Entitles person to ride any regular fixed route bus for half-fare per boarding or to purchase a Day or Monthly Pass at a reduced rate.

**Eligibility Criteria and Conditions for Senior and Disabled Persons**

In order to qualify for the Link Transit Reduced Fare ID Card you must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- Providing proof of being at least 65 years of age. DATE OF BIRTH: \_\_\_\_\_
- Proof of receiving Social Security Disability Benefits or SSI (Supplemental Security Income) Benefits due to disability.
- Presenting a valid Medicare card issued by the Social Security Administration.
- Providing proof of current eligibility by the Veterans Administration as having a disability of at least 40%.
- Having an obvious physical impairment(s) that causes difficulty in using public transportation without special planning, design or facilities.
  - Non-ambulatory (requires use of wheelchair for travel)
  - Semi-ambulatory (requires use of mobility aides; walker, crutches, leg braces)
  - Visual
  - Hearing
- Have a disability that is not obvious but effectively creates difficulty in using public transportation without special planning, design or facilities. (Applicants may be requested to provide a Washington State Disability ID Card or medical verification)
  - Neurological (Cerebral Palsy, Multiple Sclerosis, Muscular Dystrophy)
  - Developmental (Mental Retardation, Autism)
  - Other non-obvious disabilities

**Current photo identification will be required for all applicants together with proof of eligibility consistent with the above criteria.**
